
The Congressional group is private and is meant for direct communication from the Church to the Congregants, while also allowing Congregates to communicate with each other.

Signing Up For Facebook

If you do not have a Facebook account you can create one by going to: www.facebook.com It will come up and ask for some basic information and an e-mail address (see below). Once an account is created you can login and follow the directions below.

**Note: the information that you provide to Facebook can all be marked as private (except for your name). You can do so by going into the settings under "Privacy".*



Please "Like" the Church's page before joining the Congregational group. After that go to the Congregational Group at: www.facebook.com/groups/782753865472458 and click the "Join" button (see below).

It will then come up and ask which service you attend. This is a private group and we're using this as a "verification" method to limit the group to Congregants only. This means that anyone who does not belong to the group cannot see posts, photos or anything within the group beyond the page you see when you click to Join. So please answer the question and click the "Submit" button.
